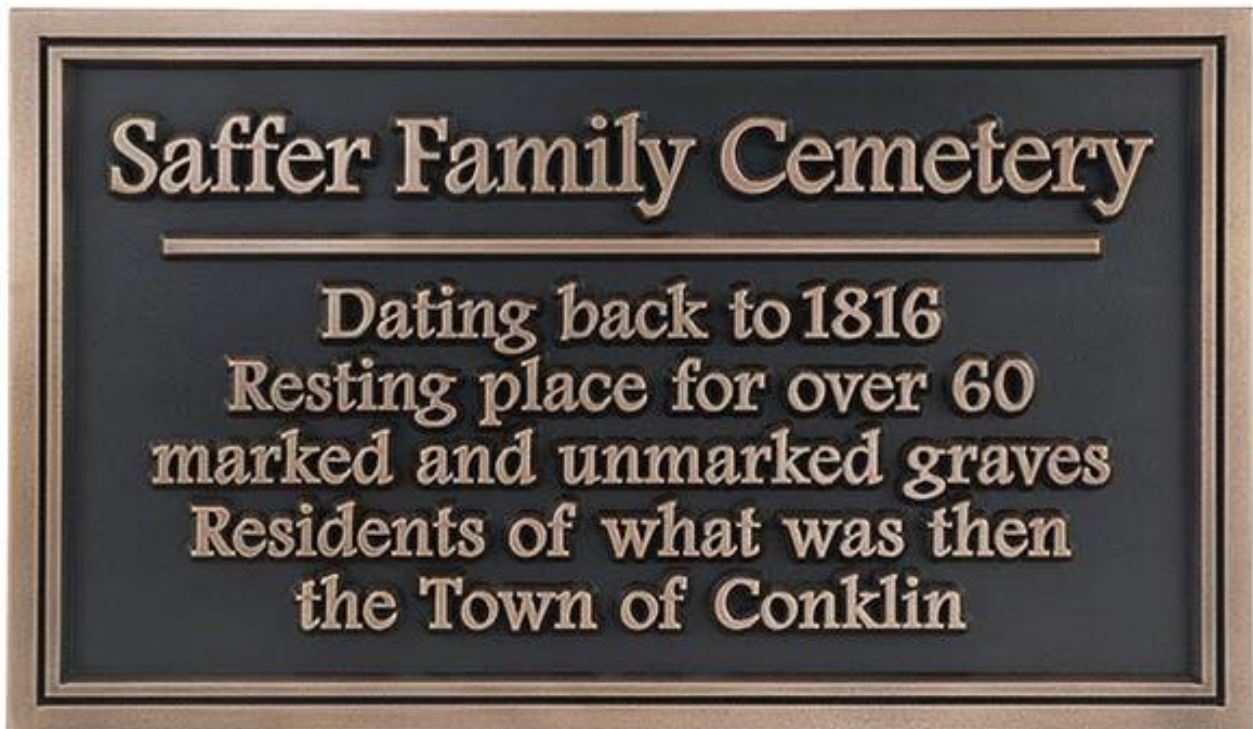

Plaque Proofs for Historic Ditch Monument

The Commission selected a style for the commemorative bronze plaque in their May meeting. The Commission liked the double border, simplistic style, and font of the sample below:



SPECIFICATIONS: The stone face of the monument is 40" W x 24" H. To fill the space appropriately yet leave a border of stone around the plaque, staff has requested the size of the plaque to be 34" W x 18"H. This will leave a 3" border of stone surrounding all sides of the plaque. The plaque has a depth of 1.25".

PROOFS: Atlas Signs & Plaques in Delta, Colorado has submitted proofs for the Commission to review and select:

Water from the Virgin River is the life blood of Zion Canyon and was crucial to the settlement of Springdale.

The first European pioneers, the Latter-Day Saints (Mormons), began building canals and ditches in 1863 to divert water from the river to their fields. Many of the waterways were lined with hand-hewn native sandstone blocks like these.

Additional stone-lined ditches were built in the 1930's by workers in the Civilian Conservation Corps (the W.P.A.).

For over 100 years these stone lined canals and ditches provided irrigation and flood control for the community.

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COST/PRODUCTION: The cost of the plaque will be \$990 + \$25 shipping. Once the order is finalized and they have received payment, production time will be 3-4 weeks with a shipping time of 1-5 days. Installation will be executed by the staff.
