Item B1: Ordinance 2021-02 – Repealing Chapter 4-8

This ordinance is the last change resulting from the new residential solid waste agreement with the County Solid Waste District. When the BluCan recycling program was started, it was under a contract separate from the District's residential garbage collection agreement. Both the new agreement between Republic and the District and the agreement between the District and the Town, which went into effect on Feb. 1st, provide for the collection of residential recycling, including the provision for user fees.

As we modified Chapter 4-5 in response to the new agreement, we included the necessary provisions for recycling into the revisions of that chapter. Chapter 4-8, which was first created in response to the start of the curbside program, is now redundant and should be repealed to clear any ambiguity between the two chapters.

This change has been reviewed and approved by the Town Attorney's office.



ORDINANCE 2021-02

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE SPRINGDALE TOWN COUNCIL
REPEALING CHAPTER 4-8 OF THE TOWN CODE**

WHEREAS, Washington County Special Service District No. 1 (District) was duly created by resolution of the Washington County Commissioners for the purpose of developing and implementing a system for the collection and disposal of solid waste generated within the boundaries of said District; and

WHEREAS, the incorporated area of the Town of Springdale is located within the boundaries of said District; and

WHEREAS, said District and the Town of Springdale have entered into a written Agreement dated August 13, 2008 governing collection and disposal of residential solid waste generated within the boundaries of Springdale, which Agreement expired on January 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, said District and Allied Waste Transportation, Inc., A Delaware corporation d/b/a Republic Services of St. George have entered into a "Residential Waste Collection Agreement", which became effective on February 1, 2021, for the continuation of solid waste collection and disposal services within the Town of Springdale, as well as other municipalities and unincorporated areas of Washington County, which agreement includes provisions for the collection of residential recycling; and

WHEREAS, said District and the Town of Springdale have entered into a written Agreement dated August 20, 2020 governing the terms and conditions upon which the District shall continue to provide solid waste collection and disposal services within the Town of Springdale, including provisions for the collection of residential recycling, which Agreement became effective on February 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2020, the Springdale Town Council adopted Ordinance 2020-08 which revised Chapter 4-5 of the Town Code regarding the collection and disposal of residential solid waste, including the collection of residential recycling,

and provided for collection and disposal fees for residential solid waste and residential recycling; and

WHEREAS, in light of the new agreements with the District and Republic Services and the revisions to Chapter 4-5, the Springdale Town Council has determined that Chapter 4-8: Curbside Residential Recycling Collection, is now redundant and should be repealed in its entirety;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Springdale Town Council that Chapter 4-8 of the Town Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.
