Mayor and Town Council,

I am providing these comments and hope they will be considered at the Wednesday, September 22nd special town council meeting where the construction/demolition of the history center building will be discussed.

I believe that the proposed design of the history center building is flawed. The access to the bathrooms is proposed to be inside. This is wrong because any activity going on will be disrupted by tourists seeking bathrooms. Public restrooms are scarce in Springdale. The history center is perfectly located for providing public restrooms with exterior access. Tourists will appreciate them. There should also be exterior benches, and perhaps an art garden with local artist's work.

I am not sure that a history center is going to work in Springdale. I don't think it will draw tourist in, but I understand that it will serve locals. However the costs to rebuild the building is mostly going to come from tourist money, not property taxes which provide only a very small amount of the town's revenue. Perhaps we should think about giving back to the tourists too.
