While I support the concept of a history center, I do not believe that River Park is the place for more cars, parking, or structures. To me, the River Park is a relatively unspoiled oasis which should be preserved as is at all costs. When the adjacent parcel was acquired by the Town, I understood the acquisition to be in support of the critical need for the preservation of open space, not the site for more cars, noise, and visitors. Is there not room on Lion Blvd, just down from the Pavillion Park? Now that the "dump" has been cleaned up, couldn't the history center move there and share space with the disc golf course? Or, put the history center on Lion Blvd near the new recreation center? I have looked at the drawings and the additional parking and pavement proposed to be located in the existing park property appear quite extensive.
