Concerning 8/10 Council meeting agenda Item C-1, the discussion of an increase in water fees

Town Council,

We share the Town concern for water conservation. We are members of the Kinesava Homeowners Association (KHAI). KHAI owns the 5 acre pasture that is irrigated with town irrigation water with a 4" pipe connection. The proposed additional fee based on volume will require our association to make significant changes and these will take time to be approved. Our next meeting is in March. We request that the proposed January 2023 date for this new fee schedule be delayed for 6-12 months to allow all irrigation users to determine the way forward that will allow us to respond to the increase, to continue to pursue ways to lower our water usage and to maintain the land in agricultural use.

The pasture has been maintained by KHAI in accordance with the town goal of maintaining traditional village character and open space and we hope to continue to do so.
