August 8: Southwest Mosquito Abatement Board Meeting. District Administrator Sean Amodt reported there have been four ponds found in Washington County with confirmed presence of the West Nile Virus.

August 9: I attended the UDOT open house in Virgin for proposed changes and development of SR-9 through the town.

August 16: I attended a stakeholder meeting at Zion Lodge to hear considerations for managing oversized vehicles use (e.g., tour bus, RVs, etc.) in the Zion tunnel. The presentation was given by the park superintendent and staff.
