Council Department Reports – TC meeting 9/13/23

Renewable Energy Program

- We have still not received the final Utility Agreement (UA) from RMP (Rocky Mountain Power). As soon as we get it, the board will review and approve it, then send it to all the communities along with informational slides.
- We are still in discussion with RMP about resource valuation. This is important because it will have a large impact on program rates.

Fire Board

- The Washington County Commissioners have pulled the sales tax referendum from the November ballot. I don't totally understand their reasoning, but it will make it very difficult to balance our next budget without depleting our reserve funds.
- We have received a number of applications for fire chief, but have not had time to whittle the list down.
- We were supposed to have our September meeting on the 5th, but it has been rescheduled for the 18th.

Pubic Works

- The Lion Blvd. sidewalk project walkthrough is scheduled for the week of the 18th.
- Interstate Rock installed a 14" valve, tee and a 4" valve on the irrigation line on Lion Blvd. while they had the shoulder dug up.
- Working with Sunrise Engineering on the sewer lagoon improvements...inflow screen, discharge pipe rip-rap and effluent TSS filter.
- Had a meeting with Sunrise and made comments on the Culinary Water Master Plan.

Streets

- Interstate Rock started paving Foothill Lane. The section done in the rain will be taken out and redone.
- Interstate Rock working on the south side of Lion Blvd.
- Working on a crosswalk traffic study. There were counts conducted on foot and vehicular traffic over Labor Day weekend. This information will be shared with UDOT when we discuss crosswalks in town.
