Town Council Report September 2023

Recreation Building Update

For the past two years the Town has explored the possibility of constructing a recreation building on what is now the ball field. The process began in 2019 with a broad survey from Parks and Recreation department where a desire for more indoor recreation options was voiced.

Throughout the process, the town took surveys, established a community health coalition, held open houses to gather input on what do you want for your indoor recreation facility. Beginning fall 2022, members of staff and the Town Council worked with NWLA on design plans and programming space for this new facility.

In April 2023, the town held a community open house with NWLA presenting six different design options. There was a Q&A session with staff, Town Council and NWLA responding to questions from the public. Approximately fifty residents participated in the open house and others submitted comments on the design plans while the plans were displayed prior to the open house.

In the May 2023 Town Council meeting, the decision was made that due to other needs such as a town hall, medical clinic, and post office, now is not the right time to move forward with the construction of the recreation building.
