Met with the Mayor, Rick, Tom and Ryan for a lunch meeting with tribal representatives for a general discussion on land owned by the tribe that is adjacent to the River Park. We also hiked a portion of the new trail.

September 21: Oversized Vehicle Use on Zion-Mount Carmel Highway

Attended the subject stakeholder meeting to continue discussion on the park's efforts to manage oversized vehicle use on the Zion-Mount Carmel Highway and the need for regional transit planning. The park has identified a flexible two-year strategy that would phase out and ultimately prohibit oversized vehicles entering the east entrance of the park. Oversize vehicles delay traffic flow 44 minutes out of every hour during times of the day when vehicle escorts are needed.
