A. Special Recognition

- 1. Recognition of Stanley J. Smith for his service as Mayor of Springdale:** Council members spoke with gratitude for the impact Mayor Smith had on the Town of Springdale during his eight-year tenure.
 - Ms. Zumpft recalled a number of projects Mayor Smith could be proud of including reconstruction of SR-9, the new water treatment plant, and building a strong relationship with Washington County. She acknowledged how he often expressed heartfelt emotion. Ms. Zumpft thanked him for teaching her restraint and appreciated that Mayor Smith always did what was right for Springdale.
 - Mr. Aton said Mayor Smith's love of Springdale was obvious at all times. Although they did not always agree, Mr. Aton respected his opinion. Mayor Smith did an amazing job reconnecting Springdale with the people down-canyon. This was his legacy.
 - Mr. Burns thanked Mayor Smith for his support. He appreciated Mayor Smith's leadership and their interaction while Mr. Burns was with the national park and on Planning Commission.

Mr. Wixom presented an award to Mayor Smith which read, *"In recognition of Stanley J. Smith, Mayor of Springdale, January 2014 – January 2022 with gratitude and appreciation for eight years of dedicated service helping to implement the Town's goals while improving the lives of residents, business owners, and visitors"*.

- Mr. Wixom thanked Mayor Smith for his friendship, guidance, and leadership. The staff always knew Mayor Smith was looking out for everyone.

Police Chief Brecke relayed a message from Town Treasurer Dawn Brecke. He said Ms. Brecke greatly appreciated the trust he placed in her and for giving credit when it was needed.

- Chief Brecke presented Mayor Smith with a sentimental gift from the old Bumbleberry. He also gave him a plaque from the Police Department which read: *"Thank you for all the sacrifices you made every day so that our lives would be better"*.

Donna Taylor recalled Mayor Smith as a child back in 1972/1973. She congratulated him on his good work.

Patsy Chaffin also remembered Mayor Smith as a kid, and his father when he was Mayor. She thanked him as a co-worker, long-time friend, and resident. He gave his heart to the Town.

Mayor Smith said the experience as Mayor stretched him personally. Times were difficult and challenging, yet rewarding. Many of the relationships and friendships he made added to his life. Mayor Smith thanked the residents for their support and criticisms. He said it all made him a better person. Mayor Smith commended the staff and police department. He believed the new Mayor and Council would do great.

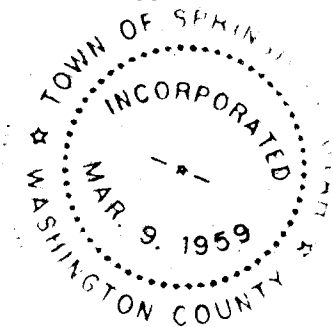
