Recreation Building

A 2019 survey completed by residents showed that there is a desire for more indoor recreation options. For the past year the Town has explored the possibility of constructing a recreation building on what is now the ball field. Members of staff and the Town Council worked with NWL Architects on programming and design of this facility.

In April 2023, the Town held a community open house where NWL presented six different design options. The comments received at that open house and in writing informed the design, which was presented to Town Council at their May 2023 meeting. At that meeting, a decision was made that other needs are more pressing than the recreation center. These needs include a medical clinic, post office, public works maintenance building, and infrastructure improvements. The Council requested that NWL complete their contract with the Town by finalizing the design, at which time the Council would reconsider its decision about priorities.

At its September 2023 meeting, the Council reaffirmed their decision to postpone construction of the recreation building until the more-pressing needs were met.

New Parks and Recreation Master Plan

Over the past several months, Town Staff has been working with Sunrise Engineering on the development of a new Parks and Recreation Master Plan for Springdale. This plan will provide direction on the Town's goals and strategy regarding the maintenance of our current recreational assets and the development of future recreational assets, such as parks, trails, and more.

In the coming weeks, a draft of the plan will be posted on the Town website for members of the community to view prior to possible adoption in our Town Council meeting. Once available, we invite you to have a look and let us know if you have any questions or thoughts.

Quantity and Quality! Angels Landing Pilot Permit Program benefits visitors to Zion National Park

Hundreds of thousands of Zion visitors want to visit Angels Landing. In years gone by, the half mile trek from Scout Lookout to the end of the route with chains took hikers hours due to the congestion and crowding.

Since 2021, the National Park Service has issued hundreds of thousands of permits and accommodated about 80% of the use the route saw before the permit system was in place. Visitors have reported, and rangers have observed that the trail is not as congested or as crowded as it was before the adoption of the permit system.

The National Park Service is continuing to monitor conditions and is experimenting with issuing permits at different times of day to see how we can build on this success. We issue hundreds of permits every day, and consistently receive positive feedback on the trail conditions. When visitors have questions, the best place to learn more is online at go.nps.gov/AngelsLanding. Some helpful tips about the program are:

- Permits are non-transferable, and we issue extra permits every day to account for permittees who do not show up.
- Hikers need to bring ID and a print or screenshot of the email that says they received a permit.
- Permit start times are at the Grotto, Shuttle Stop #6.
- Application success rates have ranged from 10% on especially busy days like holidays to 100% (with permits left over) on some slower days.

Meanwhile, the Community Health Coalition is working on ideas to improve the ball field. Anything we do will maintain flexibility for a future building and preserve much of the grassy open area. Some ideas they are considering is a walking path, more trees, a fenced dog park, outdoor exercise equipment, a climbing wall, and improved disc golf amenities. The only decision that is certain is that the site will no longer be maintained as a ball field.




Thank you to those who attended the recreation building open house and submitted written comments. We appreciate the feedback, and projects such as these are more impactful with participation from residents.

Meanwhile, the Town has completed the purchase of the medical clinic building from Mike and Helen McMahan, and Family Healthcare will begin offering services from that location in early November. The plan is to begin construction of a new building as soon as a location and funding are secured. Thanks to Mike and Helen for their years of service to so many residents of (and visitors to) Springdale. I wish them a happy, healthy, and prosperous retirement.
