It's Halftime!

I am now halfway through my 4-year term as Mayor of Springdale. The experience has been both rewarding and challenging.

I have accomplished several of my original goals -- even as I continue to add other goals to the list. While we sometimes disagreed on issues, I've been fortunate to work with dedicated Council members that do what they believe is best for the Town and its residents. In the past two years, here are some of our notable accomplishments:

- Convincing FedEx to place a drop box in the Town of Springdale (thanks, Stan Smith, for hosting the box on your property)
- Continuation of medical services in the Town of Springdale after Mike and Helen McMahan's retirement (thanks, Family Healthcare)
- Curbing the proliferation of nightly rentals and stopping the conversion of long-term housing, retail businesses, and galleries
- Creation of a workforce housing overlay zone that provides developers an incentive to build deed-restricted housing; this would allow people who work in Town or at Zion National Park to live here if they wish to do so

Springdale Dark Skies

In case you missed it, Springdale is now designated as a Dark Sky Community. The Town was required to make minor modifications to our Outdoor Lighting Ordinance and modify our street lighting to receive the International Dark Sky certification. To retain our Dark Sky Community designation, we must maintain and continuously improve low light trespass from lighting within the Town. Education and working with property owners are a vital component of successful dark sky continuous improvement.

The Town is currently in the process of doing a comprehensive light audit of all lighting in the Town of Springdale. There will be some lighting that does not meet Town Code and there will be some lighting that may meet Town Code but could be improved further to enhance our night sky. Each property owner will have the opportunity to review the results of the light audit and be given the opportunity to respond.

Additionally, the Town will be working with property owners to develop a system to recognize/reward property owners that work to substantially reduce light trespass above and beyond current Town Code. We welcome community input as the Town evaluates methods to promote dark sky enhancements in Springdale. Several Utah communities, like Moab (moabdarkskes.com), have already implemented awareness and incentive programs to preserve their dark sky.

- Securing continuous Verizon cell phone service from Rockville to LaVerkin, eliminating the "dead zone" and improving public safety
- Negotiating with fiber optics providers to secure reliable internet service for every residence in the Town of Springdale; installation will begin in January 2024 (special shout out to Rick Wixom for leading the effort with South Central Communications)
- Hiring a housing partner to develop Moderate Income Housing in Springdale, providing ownership and rental opportunities for full-time residents of Springdale

I and Council will continue to work on these outstanding items throughout the next two years:

- Ensuring the continuation of a physical post office in the Town of Springdale at the expiration of the current lease (January 2025)
- Securing property and building a medical facility to provide ongoing medical services and a retail pharmacy in Town
- Updating the cell tower ordinance with the intent of encouraging cell service providers to improve service to all residents of Springdale
- Completion of the public gathering space at the property on SR-9 in front of the Best Western Hotel
- Incorporation of the newly-acquired acre of land into the George Barker River Park
- Converting the ball field at Town Hall to an open space that could be used for events
