

Update on the Former Ball Field Area

Many of you have been asking about the work that has been done on the space-formerly-known-as-the-ball-field (don't worry, not an official name!) behind the community center. Up to this point, the infield has been removed, the chain link backstop demoed, some new concrete has been poured, and the irrigation system has been improved. The next phase will take place in spring when new sod will be laid and trees planted. The end product will be an improved green space perfect for events, playing with your dogs, or just enjoying the beauty of the canyon. The disc golf course is currently open for play, and signage will be reinstalled shortly.

Holiday Lighting

It is that time of year again and Springdale holiday lighting participation is in full swing. Holiday lighting is exempt from Town lighting codes but only from October 15 to January 15 and only if it does not create a hazard of nuisance from glare.

As part of the Town's continuing efforts to preserve our dark skies, you may receive a letter concerning a property's lighting. The courtesy letter will address lighting that will be in violation of Town Code after the January 15 exemption. Please review the Town Code Chapter 15C- Outdoor Lighting and bring property into compliance by January 16.

Exception: The Town lighting code was updated in 2021 and all properties will be required to modify lighting to meet the updated Town Code by 2028. The Town plans to begin enforcement of all previous versions of Town Code Chapter 15C.

Some property owners will receive letters concerning illumination of signage. In addition to the Town Code Chapter 15C- Outdoor Lighting there is Chapter 24 – Sign Regulations that addresses specific lighting restrictions concerning signage. If a property owner has illuminated signage, please review Chapter 24 of the Town Code.

Light trespass and light source visibility beyond property boundaries, light color temp(<3000K), and illumination after hours of business operation are the current primary violations.

So, enjoy the holidays and let's all work together to preserve our dark skies in 2025.


