Two Things



First, you've undoubtedly heard about the staffing shortage at Zion National Park. The Park has been understaffed and underfunded for years, but the situation has been exacerbated by recent firings of full-time staff by the Department of Government Efficiency. There is also some question about the availability and timely arrival of approximately 100 seasonal employees who usually show up to help in March every year.

Park staff will do their best to keep traffic flowing through Springdale and provide a great visitor experience despite the lower staffing level. Their priorities will be (1) visitor safety (especially related to traffic pinch points around the tunnel), (2) employee safety, (3) traffic and parking management for safety and to protect the natural resource, and (4) fee collection.

Please be patient with visitors and, especially, Park employees as they navigate this new situation. If you would like to volunteer to help out in the Park, contact the Volunteer Office at 435-772-0184 or zion_vip_mailbox@nps.gov.

The shuttle service will operate beginning on March 2. That service is provided by a government contractor rather than the Park, so it is staffed as usual.

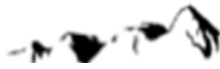

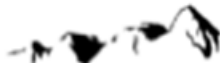
Secondly, there has been an increased level of interest in emergency preparedness because of our Rockville fire and the fires in Southern California. The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) that existed in this area is no longer active. Megan Honer-Orton, a Council member in Rockville, would like to get this going again but needs new volunteers. If you are interested, please contact her at megan@rockville.utah.org.

Training for CERT includes basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. Being prepared for disasters is important. The training hosted in Springdale by the Southwest Utah Health Department was very informative, and they emphasized that we are all responsible for our own safety. My husband and I attended that training, and we packed a "go tote" as a result of what we learned. Springdale Residential Parking Permit: What You Need to Know

Recently, the Town Council approved revisions to the ordinance and policy for residential parking in Springdale. Springdale residents can take advantage of the Residential Parking Permit Program, offering convenient solutions. Here's a quick guide to eligibility, policies, and event parking options:

Eligibility

- **Who Qualifies:** Springdale residents living in a residential dwelling within the Town of Springdale.
- **Proof of Residency:** A current Springdale utility bill, Rocky Mountain Power bill, or a rental agreement in the resident's name showing a Springdale address.
- **Permit Limit:** Each qualifying residential dwelling unit can receive up to two residential parking permits.

Permit Policy

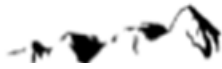
- **Application:** Submit proof of residency to apply for a permit.
- **Vehicle-Specific Permits:** Permits are tied to the vehicle's license plate number, which acts as the permit.
- **Parking Areas:** Permitted vehicles can park all day, free of charge, in paid parking areas on Lion Blvd. and Zion Park Blvd. as well as streets designated as residential permit parking areas.
- **River Park Parking:** Valid residential permits waive the standard two-hour parking limit in the River Park parking area. Now residents can park for longer durations at River Park.
- **Annual Renewal:** Permits are reviewed annually. Continued eligibility requires updated documentation.

Event Parking Permits for Residents

Residents can request Special Event Parking Permits to accommodate guests:

- **Frequency:** Up to six times per calendar year.
- **Permit Quantity:** Up to six event permits per request.
- **Date-Specific Use:** Permits are only valid on the date they are issued for.
- **Parking Privileges:**
 - Allows parking on residential streets on the event date.
 - Provides two free hours of parking on Lion Blvd. and Zion Park Blvd. on the event date.
