"Citizen of the Season"

Beginning in 2007, the Town of Springdale introduced the Citizen of the Season program to recognize individuals or groups for outstanding service to the community. Awardees are nominated by the members of the Town Council, the Town staff, and other members of the community. Each nomination is accompanied by a written summary which highlights why the person or group is deserving of the award.

While the program is imperfect in that significant contributions are made "behind the scenes" and are not recognized, it does provide a vehicle for residents to be recognized for their efforts on behalf of the community. Through their stories, others can learn more about their neighbors. It is intended to foster awareness, goodwill, and a heightened sense of community and illustrate the incredible caliber of people who live here.

Since its inception, the program has given out forty-six awards. The most recent was in 2023. If you would like to make a nomination, you can find the nomination form on the Town website. Recipients over the past ten years, from newest to oldest, are the following individuals and groups:

Downtown Plaza Update

The Downtown Plaza, a public space transformed from a bare lot over the past six months, is nearing completion. It will feature a public restroom, shaded seating, a drinking fountain (including a dog-friendly spigot!), a water bottle filling station, and bike racks.

Designed to conceptually represent Springdale's natural and geologic setting, the plaza will showcase native, drought-tolerant vegetation. It will highlight the geologic processes that created the canyon and the essential role the Virgin River has played in shaping it and sustaining human and wildlife communities.

We are excited for the project's completion and anticipate it becoming a vibrant community gathering place. By highlighting Zion Canyon's fragile beauty, we hope it will encourage visitors to be thoughtful and respectful during their visits.

The plaza is expected to be complete by late July. We look forward to hosting the community at a ribbon cutting and grand opening ceremony in late July or early August. Stay tuned for more details.

We have recently adopted some new changes to our Jolley-Gifford Cemetery policy. One of the changes we would like to make you aware of is our size restrictions on headstones/monuments; there are different width restrictions for a single or double headstone, but the max height on any monument is 36".

We would also like to remind you to clean up your decorations periodically or we may remove them if they interfere with turf maintenance or become damaged by the elements. Our policy can be found on the Town's website if you would like to know more.

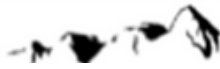

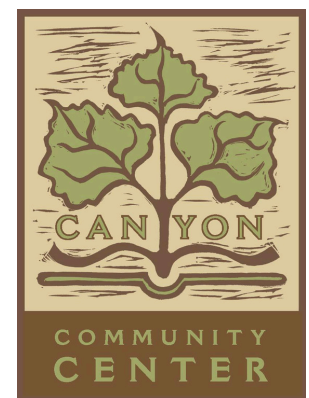

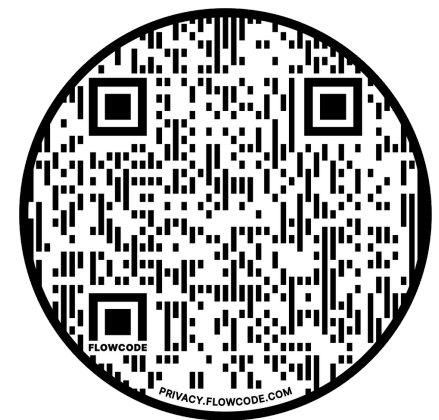
Nominations are reviewed by the Town Council and Town Staff. If approved, the awardee's name is added to the plaque hanging in the Canyon Community Center.
