The goal is to guide new development in a way that protects and promotes the health of the river corridor. Come see what is being proposed and offer your feedback and insight.

## A Steady Course in BluCan Recycling

As the BluCan Recycling Program continues to move forward, here are some additional details:

- ❖ The original guidelines for what can be included in your BluCan have not changed. You can recycle loose paper, cardboard, plastic bottles & milk jugs (with a recycle plastic designation of 1 or 2), and metal food cans.
- ❖ The fees each household has paid since the inception of the program have covered the cost of uninterrupted curbside pickup, not the actual cost of processing recyclables.
- ❖ A new processing partnership is getting underway and recycling will soon resume under that partnership.
- ❖ Recycling fees will remain the same through January 2021 as the contract with recycling providers is fulfilled.
